

Christian Lead Preschool Teacher - two days per week

General Qualification

- The applicant must be a mature, sincere Christ-follower.
- Must be at least 19 years of age.
- Must complete preschool licensing requirements including meeting the educational requirements for lead teacher (BCAL R400.8122), fingerprinting, blood-borne pathogens class, CPR and First Aid certification, I-Chat clearance, TB test, & some online training.
- Must be able to lift and carry at least 40 pounds.
- Must be active in a Bible-believing church.
- Must be in agreement with the FBC Statement of Faith (<https://gofbchart.org/about/>).
- Must be a positive role model in character and faith.

Responsibilities

- Promotes a positive, play-based kindergarten-readiness learning environment.
- Supervises and ensures the safety and well-being of the children at all times.
- Relates well with students, parents, and staff.
- Implements the preschool program reliably, from 7:45am - 3:15pm on assigned days.
- Ensures regular observation of children throughout the year.
- Publishes weekly newsletters with classroom information for families.
- Maintains daily child attendance logs and safety inspection of materials and environment.
- Attends required trainings/meetings to complete 16 clock hours of professional development on topics relevant to job responsibilities per calendar year.
- Meets with parents to discuss child(ren)'s growth and development using approved progress report forms.
- Participates in annual preschool events (orientation, Grandparents Day, Christmas program & closing program).
- Is familiar with state regulations as well as with program policies of OCS.
- Builds relationships with the families of the classroom (at drop off/pick up times, via phone calls, text messages, emails, etc).
- Models a consistent walk with Jesus Christ in speech, actions and attitude.
- Reports to the program director.
